Historical roughly background of Sayed Aabad High School

Sayed Aabad High School has been established for the first time in 1937 as primary school in the house of community elder Malik Yarjan in Lawar village. After three years, it has been shifted permanently onto the donated land by Mr. Mohammed Aman in village of Aman Khail and government has built 8 rooms school there. The school has been shifted to new building on year 1941. The school has upgraded to secondary level in 1957 and graduated student from class 9 for three years. Then the school has upgraded to high school level in 1969 and was graduating regularly the student up to 1979. By emergence of new political situation and change in security situation, the school has been destroyed in 1980. In 1994, once again the school activated and has been graduating regularly the students from grade 12 and continued up to date. The graduates from Sayed Aabad high school has been admitted into many good educational institutes in Kabul and other part of the country with high scores. Every year 100-120 students pass their study in the school and introduced to other universities and technical institution. Total number of student is now 1492 and each grade has three classes and teaching them in two shifts. The school is functional in two buildings those have totally has 36 rooms. Only 30 of them are used for teaching and 6 of them are for other administrative purposes. Total number of employees including teachers and administrative staff are 63 persons. Out from the total, 49 person are teachers that 7 of them has higher education, 10 has 14 grade education and 32 persons has only high school level education. It has 1 principal, 2 assistant principals, and 2 head masters, 1 admin officer, 1 storekeeper, and 2 cleaners.

The school is controlled by a council consisted from local communities influential elders, and teachers headed by active retired General Alhaj Joma Gul Armanjan. Total number of council are 10 persons. There is also a small medical unit inside the school operated by district basic health clinic. Meanwhile, there is a cooperative fund box which has been controlled by a council consisted from 4 people, one from community, one from teachers, one from administrative staff of school and one from student. Right now there are 6 unit desk top computers in school that provide teaching to students of classes 10th 11th and 12th for one hours in a week.

Right now the Sayed Aabad high school requires, supply of teaching materials, more computers, library, libratory and rooms for stores.

At the end we on behalf of entire staff of school and student would like to highly appreciate the honest and effective effort of Dr. Yahya Wardak who has donated number of good books to the library of school and supported us. We hope his further ability on more support our school in future.
